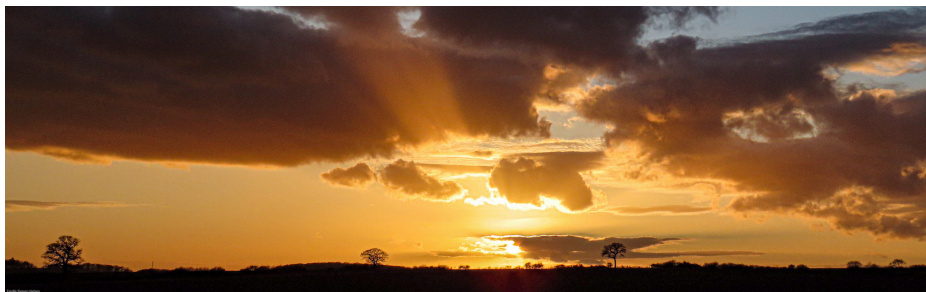

Letter from the Rector

Praying for our villages

Dear friends,

Prayer is something many people do, even if they do not consider themselves to be religious. There is a sense that prayer connects us with a 'higher power', and that it makes a difference. I well remember a conversation about prayer I had several years ago with a Christian priest from India. He told me how he was convinced that 'prayer changes things'. It reminds me of those words of the poet Tennyson who once remarked that 'more things are wrought by prayer than this world dreams of'.

Later this month, we begin the season of Lent. On Ash Wednesday, many churches hold services which include the opportunity to receive ashing - the sign of the cross marked on our foreheads with ash made from burnt palm crosses. This richly symbolic act reminds us of our mortality, and also of our baptismal calling to follow Jesus and to shine with His light: 'Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return. Turn away from sin and be faithful to Christ'. If you would like to take part in one of these Ash Wednesday services, there will be one in Waltham Church at 9.00 am, and one in Eastwell Church at 7.00 pm on Wednesday, 18th February.

Prayer is vital, if we are to follow Jesus Christ. The Gospels tell us that Jesus Himself made times of prayer spent with God a priority, and that He also taught His followers how to pray - including giving them the words of what we now know as The Lord's Prayer. If prayer was so important for Jesus, then how important it should also be for Christians everywhere.

During the Wednesdays of Lent (and Holy Week), I invite you to join me in praying for our Ironstone villages, churches and people. Each week at 7.30 pm, we will meet to pray in one of the parish churches as follows ...

Wednesday 25 th February	St Egelwin Scalford (with Chadwell and Wycomb)
Wednesday, 4 th March	St Mary Magdalene Waltham on the Wolds
Wednesday, 11 th March	St Denys Eaton
Wednesday, 18 th March	St Michael and All Angels Eastwell
Wednesday, 25 th March	St Denys Goadby Marwood
Wednesday, 1 st April	St Peters Stonesby

Each week the guided time of prayer will conclude with a service of Compline (Night Prayer), and we should be finished by 8.15 pm. You would be most welcome to come to any of our Village Prayers and Compline - just turn up by 7.30 pm.

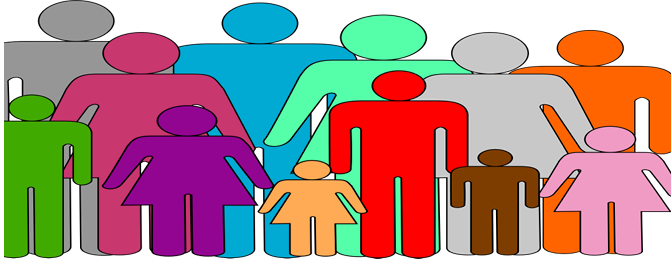

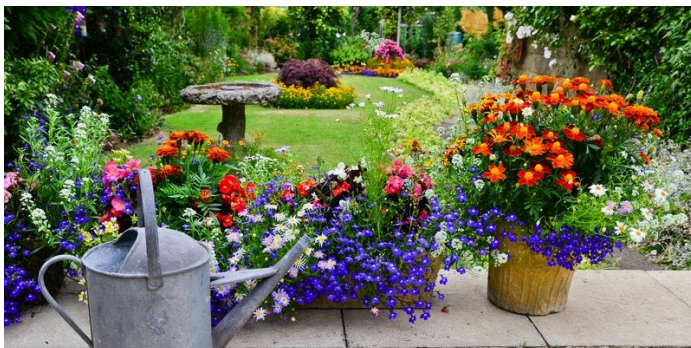

EASTWELL HISTORY GROUP



Following his talk on RAF Langar in June, historian Brian Fare is returning to make a presentation on the history and role of RAF Melton Mowbray in WWII. This will take place at Eastwell Village Hall on Wednesday, 4th March at 7.30 pm. Based on the huge attendance last time Brian spoke, we can expect that space will be in demand. Access will be free to paid-up members and under 16s. Non-members will be charged £4 admission, pay on the door.

RAF Melton Mowbray was a Class A airfield and originally intended for aircraft maintenance, but was taken over by RAF Transport Command. Many types of aircraft were flown from the airfield, including Supermarine Spitfire, de Havilland Mosquito, Vought Corsair, Vultee Vengeance, Grumman Hellcat, Douglas Dakota and Handley Page Halifax aircraft, plus Airspeed Horsa and Waco Hadrian gliders.
